ORDER

IT APPEARING to the Court that Subsection 3 of §17.1-207 of the Virginia Code authorizes the Chief Judge of the Circuit Court, in conjunction with the Chief Judge of the Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court, to close the Clerk's office of the Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court and court operations, to the extent deemed necessary, whenever they determine that operation of the Clerk's office, under prevailing conditions, would constitute a threat to the health and safety of the clerk's office personnel or the general public; and it further

APPEARING that from 12:00 p.m., (noon), on Thursday, August 20, 2009, until Wednesday, August 26, 2009, the Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court for the 19th Judicial District will be relocating from 4000 Chain Bridge Road, Fairfax, Virginia, to 4110 Chain Bridge Road, Fairfax, Virginia, entailing moving of files, office furniture and equipment from 4000 Chain Bridge Road, Fairfax, Virginia, and that this move will require packing and movement of these items within the 4000 Chain Bridge Road facility which would constitute a threat to the health and safety of the Clerk's office personnel and/or the general public; it is therefore

ORDERED that except for services set forth below, the Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court for the 19th Judicial District and the Clerk's office of that Court shall be closed from 12:00 p.m., (noon), on Thursday, August 20, 2009, until 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday, August 26, 2009, when it shall re-open for full operation at 4110 Chain Bridge Road, Fairfax, Virginia; and it is further

ORDERED that Emergency Protective Orders will be handled by the Magistrate's offices during this period of closure of the Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court as they are handled during holidays; and it is further

ORDERED, that during this period of closure of the Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court, emergency removal proceedings will be processed through the Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court's intake office which shall continue to operate during this time at existing facilities outside of 4000 Chain Bridge Road, Fairfax, Virginia, and also in the Juvenile Detention Center at
